Next, we'll eniov the festivities of the Cherry Blossom Festival and the Mulberry Street Arts & Crafts Festival. Enjoy hundreds of fine, quality vendors and craftsmen displaying their artistic creations and unique works. Lunch is on our own. Choose from an array of wonderful locally owned eateries and sidewalk cafes or grab a bite at the International Food Fair located inside the gates of the festival. This afternoon, we tour Hav House. This is Macon's premier antebellum home, the "Palace of the South" featured on A&E's American Castles. A delicious dinner is included this evening

at Michael's on Mulberry. This 150 year old cafe was once an old stagecoach shop. D
